A Home Energy Assessment may help improve the comfort of your home as well as lower your energy bills. An energy advisor will guide you step-by-step in identifying long-term, cost-effective, energy-saving opportunities in your home. Following, you will receive a comprehensive report (valued at \$250) of recommended low- and no-cost energy-saving solutions. These solutions may reduce your energy bills by as much as 30% after installation or implementation! A Home Energy Assessment may also include:

- Analysis of heating and cooling system to determine operating efficiency
- Additional instant discounts on insulation installation contractor invoice (up to \$700) if your insulation levels meet the eligibility requirements
- Additional instant discounts on your air sealing contractor invoice (up to \$200)

On-the-spot installation of some or all of the following energy-saving products:

- Smart Wi-Fi thermostat (Home must have pre-existing standard thermostat and Wi-Fi)
- ENERGY STAR® certified LED lighting
- Duct sealing
- Sink faucet aerators

Do you qualify?

- You must be a NIPSCO customer with active service
- Your home must be more than five (5) years old
- You have not had a NIPSCO-sponsored energy assessment in the past three (3) years
- You have not had a NIPSCO Income Qualified Weatherization in the past three (3) years

Please note:

- You do not need to be the homeowner, but you will need permission from the landlord or property owner before the installation of any permanent products
- The homeowner or account holder must be at least 18 years of age and must be in the home for the entire duration of the assessment
